## FEBRUARY 25

### MARCH 6

Isaiah 58:11 “And the Lord will guide you continually and satisfy your desire in scorched places and make your bones strong; and you shall be like a watered garden, like a spring of water, whose waters do not fail.”

### MARCH 7

James 1:5 “If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given to him.”

### MARCH 12

1 Peter 1:3 “Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! In his great mercy He has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead.”

### MARCH 13

Psalm 103:8 “The Lord is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, abounding in love.”

### MARCH 14

Isaiah 43:25: “I am He who blots out your transgressions for my own sake, and I will not remember your sins.”

### MARCH 25

John 13:34 “A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another.”

### MARCH 26

1 Peter 3:8 “Finally, all of you, be like-minded, be sympathetic, love one another, be compassionate and humble.”

### MARCH 27

Ephesians 4:31-32 “Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice. Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.

### MARCH 28

Galatians 5:13 “You, my brothers and sisters, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the flesh; rather, serve one another humbly in love.”
